Tip of the Month - Reminders for Boaters

Tip 1. For you boaters: Just a reminder.

For those boat owners out there, hopefully before your boat was put up for winter storage you filled the gas tank and added fuel stabilizer to help prevent condensation and therefore water in the fuel. Not Good.

This time of year I add in some extra fuel stabilizer just to help prevent that issue.

Tip 2. Downriggers: For those of you using downriggers with steel line, it's a good idea to reel off all the line and take a look to make sure there are no rust spots or frayed areas.

If you have any frayed areas, be sure to replace your line. I failed to do this last year and sure enough on a fishing trip, lost my 12lb downrigger ball because the steel line broke and you know they are expensive.

Also a good idea to carry an extra downrigger belt.

Recipe of the Month

Pineapple Teriyaki Salmon

From "Cooking Light" 2007

QUICK & EASY

Pineapple Teriyaki Salmon

(pictured on page 234)

You can round out the meal with sautéed haricots verts and quick-cooking couscous.

- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons low-sodium soy sauce
- 1 teaspoon finely grated orange zest
- 1 (6-ounce) can pineapple juice
- ½ teaspoon salt, divided
- 2 teaspoons canola oil
- 4 (6-ounce) salmon fillets (about 1 inch thick)
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Grated orange rind (optional)

- **1.** Combine first 4 ingredients and ½ teaspoon salt in a small saucepan over high heat, and bring to a boil. Reduce heat, and simmer until reduced to ½ cup (about 15 minutes). Set aside.
- 2. Preheat oven to 400°.
- 3. Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Sprinkle both sides of fish with ½ teaspoon salt and pepper. Add fish to pan; cook 3 minutes. Turn fish over, and place in oven; bake at 400° for 3 minutes. Remove from oven; brush 1 tablespoon sauce over each fillet. Return to oven, and cook 1 minute or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork or until desired degree of doneness. Sprinkle with orange rind, if desired. Yield: 4 servings (serving size: 1 salmon fillet).
